- ▣ When submitting photos please remember:
  - Must be a jpeg file: \*.jpg
  - Filename starts with your name, then 1-up number based on your choice of priority for showing; no description in the filename; include EXIF data
  - Size is set in number of pixels, not in dpi or inches
  - Long side about 1024 pixels
  - Resizing can be done in Windows Explorer, Finder, Faststone, Irfanview, Photoshop Elements, Photoshop, Picasa, many others
