Administered in June, taken by 43 members


Top 3 reasons members join:



- ► Good news: almost every speaker was in someone's top 3
- Showcases: 94% enjoyed them, 74% participated Top reason for not participating: Apprehension about showing photos

To improve Showcases: Announce them in advance, allow more time to discuss, show them when scheduled, calibrate the projector

- Challenges: 93% enjoyed them, 54% participated Top reason for not participating: No time
- ▶ 74% are OK with having member reviewers vs. outside reviewers

To improve Challenges: Post schedule well in advance, consider having 2 reviewers or the same people serve as reviewers, explain the theme to outside reviewers

- Top reason for not participating in Long Term Projects: No time
- 88% enjoy Ego Alleys
 Top reason for not participating: No time
- To improve Ego Alleys: Shorten the time allotted, announce schedule well in advance, meeting room isn't conducive to critiques

Field Trips

 81% enjoy the field trip showcases; 64% participated Top reason for not participating: No time
 Top fee willing to pay: \$11-\$20




