After the presentation, Mr. Harris will join the club in the Chaney Gallery to answer questions. The People's Choice Award for the exhibit will also be announced and presented in the Chaney Gallery during this meeting.

Additionally, the public is invited to cast a vote for their favorite photograph. Voting for the People's Choice Award will take place on March 21, 2010 from 1-4 p.m. in the Chaney Gallery. The People's Choice voting results will be announced and the award presented in the Chaney Gallery as a part of DPCA's regular meeting on April 12th between 8-9 p.m. Juror, Susana Raab, a documentary and editorial photographer based in Washington, D.C. 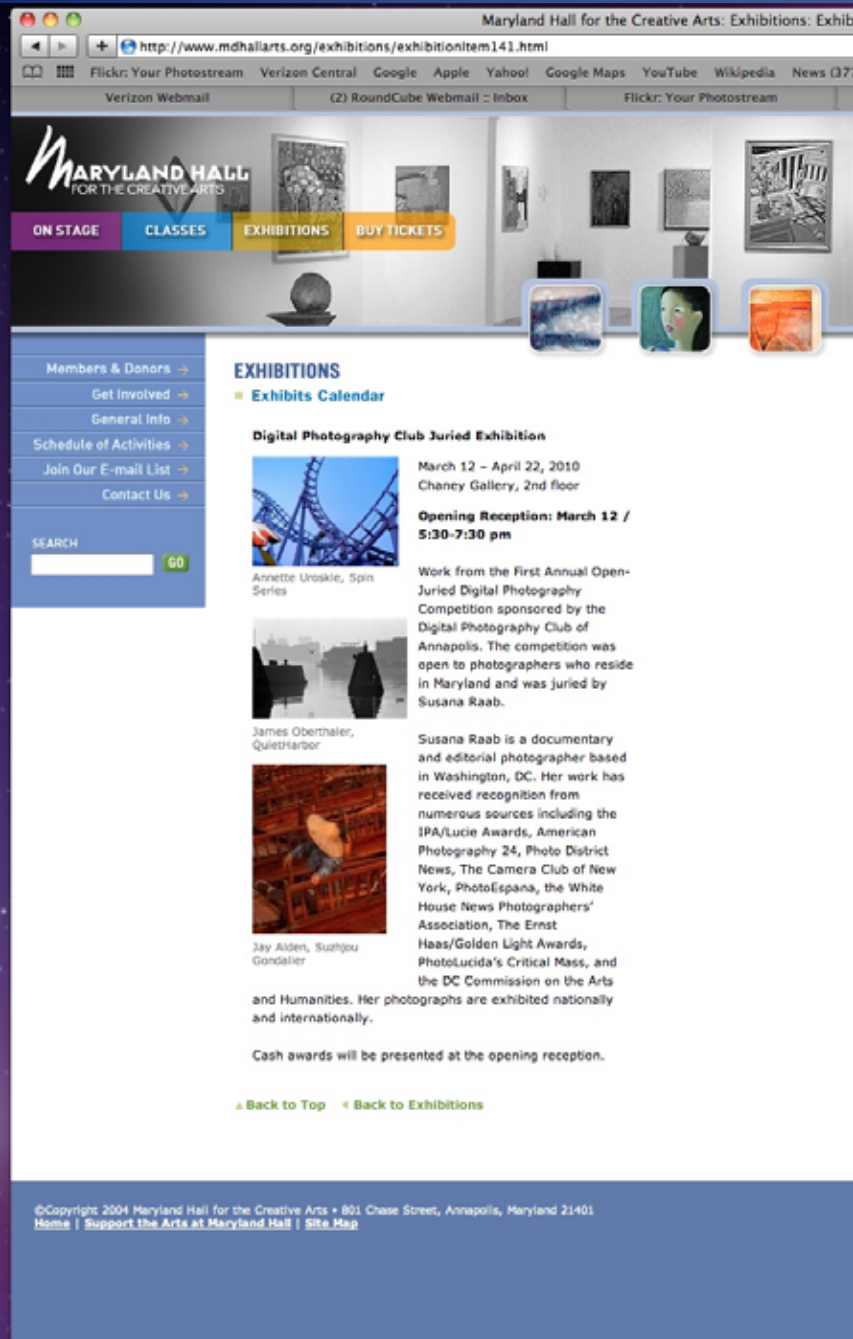
