Challenge for the December 13th meeting:
 Low Light Photography:
 Moonlight Emphasis

- Full moon is on November 21st.
- Deadline for photo submittals is Monday December 6th. Maximum number of 3 photos only.

WHAT IS LOW LIGHT PHOTOGRAPHY?

- Low light photography is having to do mainly with subject matter taken between dusk and dawn and most often uses only available light. The light is so low in intensity that it typically requires the use of a tripod. This is most often done with a long shutter speed exposures >= 1/15 sec, wide f-stops, and higher than normal ISO settings.
- This challenge asks that you try to get at least a minimum of one moonlight composed photo with your subject material. The moon need not be visible in your photo. However, using moonlight is not mandatory for this challenge only emphasized. All other photos can be all other low light compositions of your choice.
