Why Abstract Photography


- Elicits strong perceptual or emotional reaction.
- Can do it anywhere.






Form

- Shape of objects in image.
- Core element of image.
- Pleasing, interesting, dynamic shape.

- Just flows gracefully or dynamically.





Rule of thirds.


