
Begin with a brush

Right click the brush icon.




Select a style

Your cursor will now look like the brush





Oops!

Resize & Rotate the image







# Darken a layer to age the image.


As Don Dement has said a hundred times, BLACK Lightens - white darkens.


Adjust Opacity

Use levels to darken the picture then a brush to lighten select areas.












# It's time to mat and frame


- What are the steps?
  - Estimate how much mat your want and make a new blank image that size.
  - Select a color from your image and apply.
  - Choose a brush(s), pattern or texture and apply – *get creative*
  - Resize the canvas for a frame.
  - Select a frame color.
  - Selecta frame.




Make a new blank file slightly larger than your photo Image. Pick a color from your image and use the paint bucket tool to color the canvas.




Drag the image onto the background layer



Select a brush and create a pattern on the background.  
Instead of a brush you could select a pattern or texture  
from the Effects tools.




Resize the canvas to create space for a frame




Frame selection

Color the canvas extension. I selected the green moss on the front of the beam in my photo image and painted the border. Once the border is colored select the frame style and apply.







# Brushes





Brushes are monochromatic. You may choose/create a color, adjust the size and the opacity.





